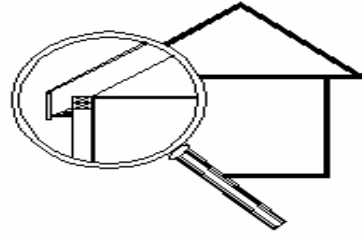

2012 IBC Update (Morning Class)

This seminar introduces participants to the major changes from the 2009 IBC to the 2012 IBC with an emphasis of the changes contained in Chapters 1-11. The lecture and activity format allows participants to discuss the changes, reasons for the changes, and allow participants to apply these new code requirements to design, plan review and/or inspection.
